The applications provide export of electronic health information (EHI) for a single patient as well as for patient population in the following formats:

1. **CCDA:** iPatientCare supports bulk export of HL7 CCDA xml files which comply to <u>United States</u> <u>Core Data for Interoperability (USCDI)</u>, Version 1 requirements.
