The applications provide export of electronic health information (EHI) for a single patient as well as for patient population in the following formats:

1. **CCDA:** iPatientCare supports bulk export of HL7 CCDAs which comply to [United States Core Data for Interoperability \(USCDI\)](#), Version 1 requirements.
